North River Shores College Scholarship Criteria & Checklist

The North River Shores Board of Directors has approved three (3) \$500 scholarships for college-bound graduating high school students and current college students of North River Shores members.

Criteria:

- Application must be received on or before May 15th (late applications will not be considered).
- Applicant's family must have been a member in good standing (dues paid) for two years prior to application.
- Applicant may be a high school senior graduating in May/June or currently enrolled in college.
- Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA for the current school year (through the third nine week grading period).
- Applicant must have resided in North River Shores for a minimum of two years prior to application.
- Applicant must submit three letters of recommendation, one must be from a NRS member in good standing.
- Applicant must submit a minimum 500 word essay (not to exceed 700 words) "Living and Growing Up in North River Shores What It Means to Me". Please include any personal information you want the Scholarship Committee to consider.

Application Checklist:

- Complete the application and attach all required documents (incomplete applications will not be considered by the Scholarship Committee). Don't forget to include your volunteer activities.
- Attach an official transcript showing your GPA (must be a minimum of 3.0 GPA)
- Attach your 500 word essay, typed 12 point font, NOT handwritten
- Attach 3 letters of recommendation (one must be from a NRS member in good standing)

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
